TOWBAR SA17AU FOR For SA17A/ SA17AQ

MATERIALS

Cross Bar. Α

D M12 x 35 x 1.75 Bolts, Lock Washers and Flat Washers (25mm O.D). 4

ZΕ 1 Electrical Plate (ZEP2)

ZQ ZQ Illustrated 1

For use with either

SA17A Flange neck option - ZF2003. Note: This towbar must be used with either a Witter Towball (part number Z11) or Class A50-1 or A50-X towball, which dimensionally conforms to A50-1 with a 'D' and 'S' value greater than or equal to that of the

SA17AQ Detachable neck option - ZQ2003. Please refer to ZQ fitting instructions for installation SA17AQF Detachable neck option – ZQF2003. Please refer to ZQF fitting instructions for installation

FITTING

- 1. Remove Bumper. (5 tip screws in each wheel arch, 7 tip screws along bottom edge of bumper, 3 tip screws under each light cluster. Pull tips outwards and slide bumper rearward, disconnect fog lamps, reversing light and reversing sensors (if present).
- 2. Remove crash beam and refit bolts into back panel to prevent ingress of water. Hand crash beam to final user for refit when bar is removed. On certain models a plastic cover over vent on rear panel will require removing.
- Insert towbar (A) into chassis rails and attach using bolts (D) in position shown. Note: holes in chassis side may be hidden under tape.
- Attach preferred and Electrical Plate (ZE) as per separate Instruction.
- 5. Cut bumper as shown and refit, it is advisable to protect bumper around neck area whilst refitting.

Note:

Please refer to the vehicle specification for the trailer weight and nose limits, which must be observed. Recommended torque settings: M8 - 27Nm, M10 - 53 Nm, M12 - 95 Nm, M14 - 150 Nm, M16 - 214 Nm
